Minutes of the Meeting held on Thursday 19th May 2022 at the Parish Hall, Montrey Crescent

2022/03 *Public Participation

A resident raise a query over land bordered by Smock Lane, Garswood Road, Billinge Road, Lapwing and Skylark (on endangered list) and Snipe. He reported it was promised by Planning that no work would start until nesting season is over. Unfortunately the birds have now disappeared so the damage has been done. He reported this wildlife crime to the police (who responded the same day) but he is unaware of the outcome of this. It was requested the Clerk write to Planning. Further concerns were expressed in relation to the extremely large vehicles bringing plant to the site and concerns and the disruption that can be expected should it be eventually developed.

Query over the government's 'brownfield first' stance and asked if this could make any difference in our area. Cllr S Murphy spoke about the need for identified land otherwise the government will impose it. The recent (now deferred) consultation from Persimmon was mentioned. Cllr S Murphy reiterated from previous Minutes that the appropriate infrastructure needs to be in place prior to Parish Council supporting any planning application (especially transport) and that 106 monies should be given prior to development. A point was made re water neutrality (developer to ensure supply is sufficient for demand) – the planning process will ensure sufficiency.

Northern Rail – query restoring two trains per hour. Cllr Pearson commented Northern Rail is resistant to changes at the moment. He also commented in relation to bus services and reiterated these will come back under the regulation of local authorities. There was a request for Cllr Robinson to return to a future meeting. Cllr S Murphy updated on some improvements to the waiting room issues but reiterated news on the bridge maintenance and repair issues are awaited.

Cllrs Peter Peers and Colin Betts were present as the newly-elected Ward Councillors and commented they are hoping to hold surgeries in Seneley Green.
