Concerns over development in greenbelt area (specifically top of Arch Lane). Lots of material being tipped. Five seed containers. Notice gone up today for boarding kennels in Arch Lane (Arch Lane Farm). Objections have been raised mainly re noise.

**Resolved:** for the Clerk to liaise with Planning at St Helens over both issues Note: reported again to Planning

Comment re rail travel and the need to keep up the work to retain services especially as the bus service is also poor. 'Tap ons' are essential in recording use. Ramps and platforms – no spontaneity of travel for those with disability/mobility issues (including those with young children/babies)

## Resolved: for the Clerk to write to LCR Transport

Station Road bus stop. Reconfigured the pavement. Comment re having fixed ramps and if they can do it at bus stops?

For the Clerk to write to LCR Transport Committee to ask again re 'tap on' machines and also to propose the fixed ramps idea.

Note: written to LCR (Steve Rotheram)

Any chance of solar lighting at the MUGA – young people could play at night and provide a place for training.

Resolved: For the Clerk to contact Ward Councillors/St Helens Council in relation to providing solar lighting at their MUGA

Pathway around periphery of playing fields:Gemma Ireland – grants available for pathways and she would need to set up a business case so to write to her.

Resolved: For Parish Council make official representation to Gemma Ireland at St Helens Council .
